Protecting IP and Licensing Technology In & Out (Part 2/3)

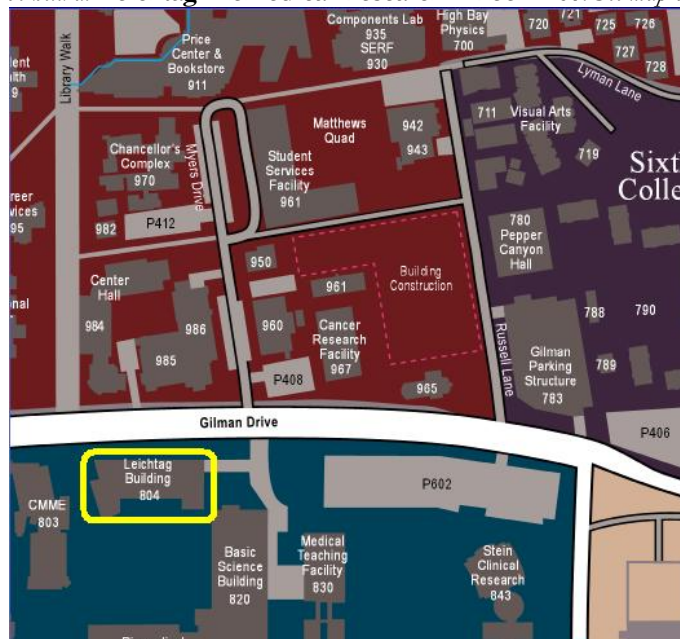
